It is anticipated that the FirstNet network will be deployed during 2018. The grant will support terrorism preparedness by funding end user equipment for Bay Area agencies to operate on the FirstNet nationwide public safety broadband network. Funding will pay for approximately 200 handheld "smart phone" type devices to be distributed equitably among Bay Area operational areas that adopt FirstNet services. Devices will be capable of operating on the FirstNet spectrum band class 14, or easily upgraded to the FirstNet band when the service is available. User training to be provided by FirstNet.
