**Project Purpose** - Improve ability to provide life-sustaining commodities after a disruption in critical lifelines and services.

The Bay Area has been awarded [Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program](#) funds to enhance distribution capabilities across the region for life sustaining commodities in a disaster.  
The Bay Area UASI Commodity Points of Distribution (C-POD) Project is based on analysis of the Bay Area's risks and hazards and potential impacts on our communities and infrastructure. The project builds upon previously developed, UASI funded, plans and tools including the:

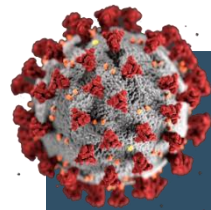
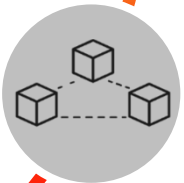
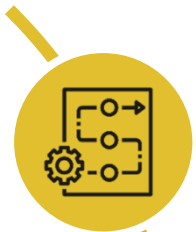


# FY19 C-POD Project Update

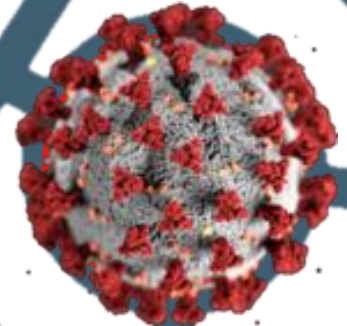
