 - 103 keys exchanged among 6 counties + 3 federal partners
- Coordination with CalOES on California Radio Interoperable System
- Implementation of Standardized Regional Alias Scheme
- Enhanced focus on security

Public Safety Broadband

- Represented Bay Area broadband needs in the national FirstNet Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC)
- Provided support to Bay Area jurisdictions considering adoption of FirstNet services
- Supported FirstNet testing and evaluation across the region






Continue only Critical Functions



BayRICS has been on the path of reducing our reliance on grant funds for operations. (decline of UASI funds 10K annually as reported

Though BayRICS future strategy will necessitate a decrease in the General Manager's contract, BayRICS does not anticipate any major impacts to the **Critical Functions**.

As the BayRICS Strategic Plan is implemented, BayRICS will work with the UASI Management Team to identify sustainable communications' funding strategies to meet any identified gaps.
