Background

At the March 2020 Approval Authority meeting, regional project concepts were approved for submission as FY20 National Priority Projects (NPP). The UASI FY20 Notice of Funding Opportunity determined the NPP focus areas as Enhancing Cyber Security, Enhancing Protection of Soft Targets and Crowded Places, Enhancing Information & Intelligence Sharing, and Addressing Emergent Threats. At least one NPP submission was required to address Election Security.

Discussion

The Management Team worked with Bay Area THIRA/SPR criteria and key stakeholders to develop competitive National Priority Projects for submission to DHS/FEMA. The following four projects were approved for funding. An overview of each FY20 National Priority Project status is presented in Appendix A.
