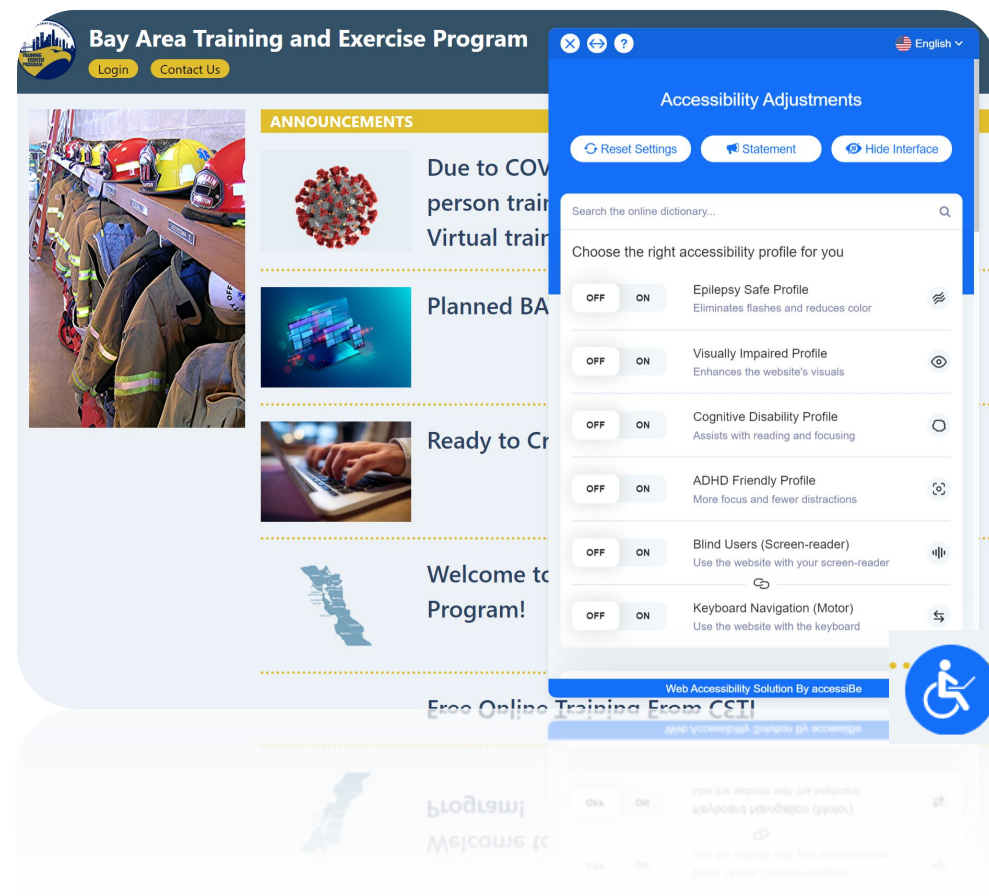

 - October workshops to identify 2021 training priorities

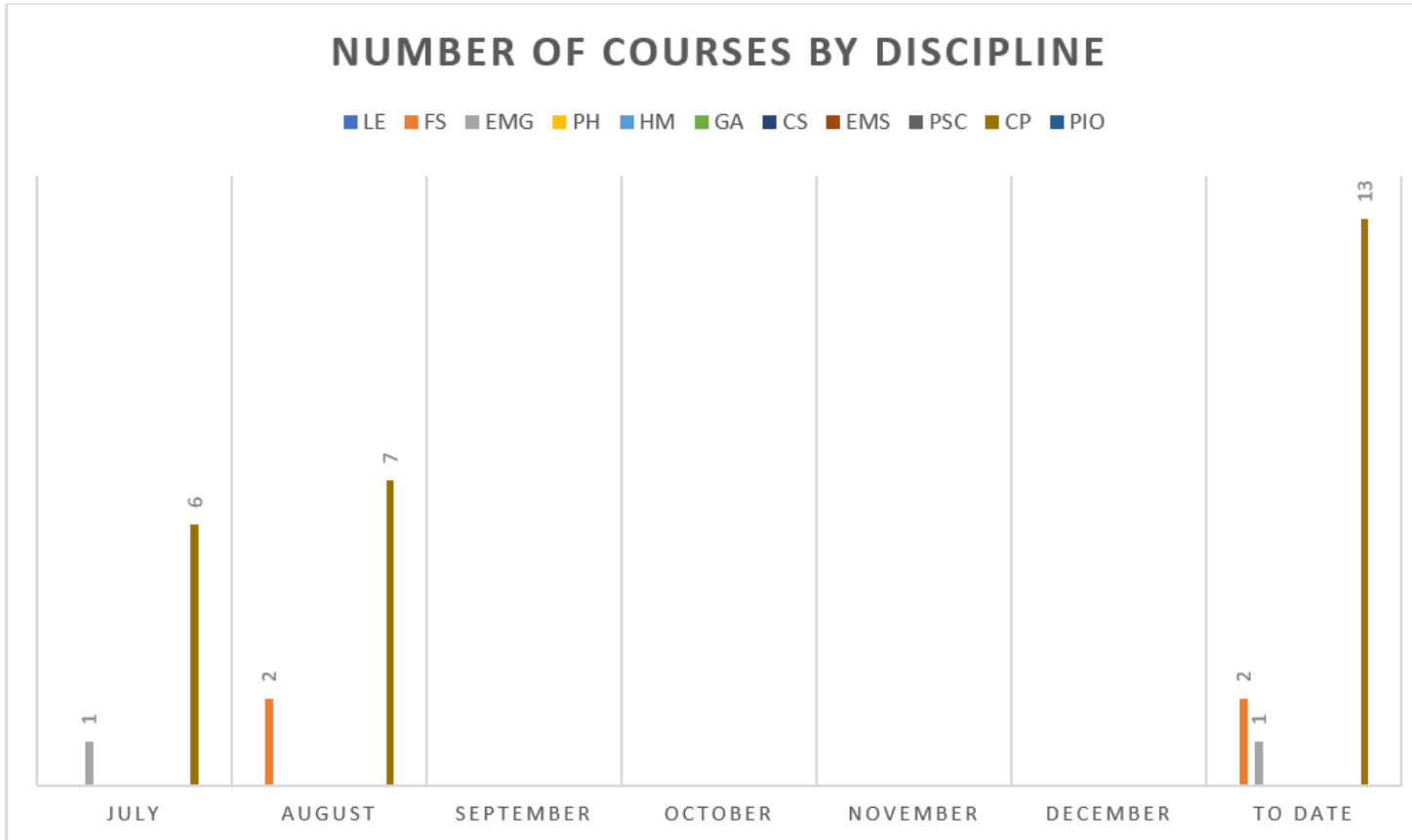
Integrated Preparedness Planning

- **Six virtual workshops planned; Health Group included**

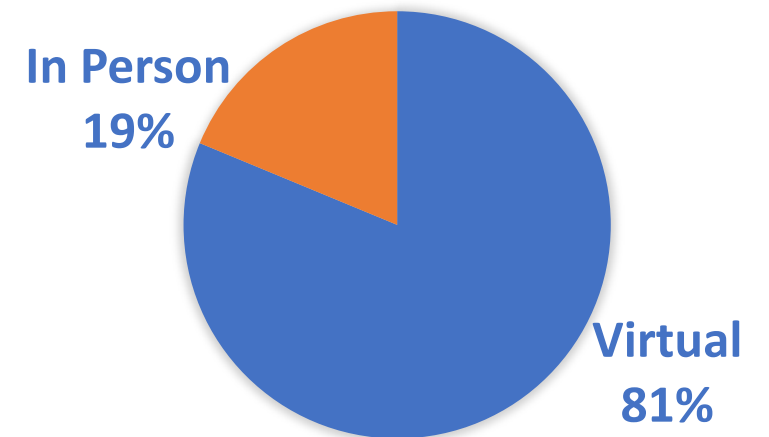
Training Conduct July – August 2020

2020 Training Opportunities

- 136 courses planned per IPP
 - 72 virtual course offerings
 - 5 in-person water rescue courses
 - 59 in-person courses postponed due to COVID
